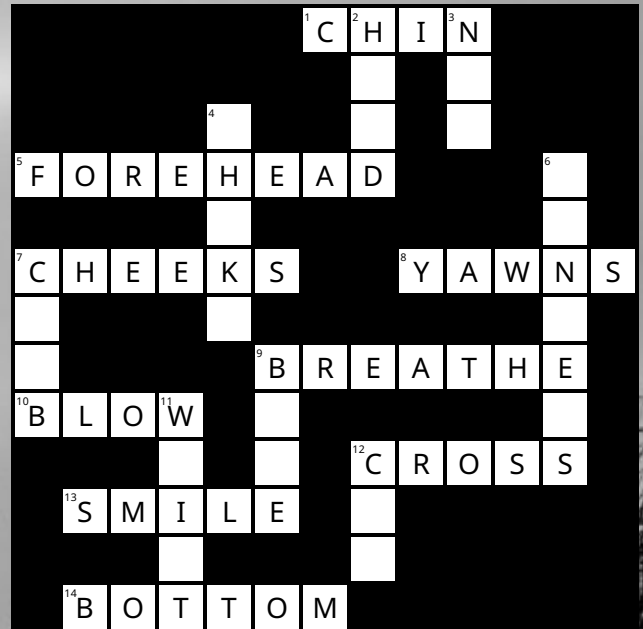


An intermediate level crossword for English language learners
